**Auto repair, tool & spare parts kit:**

Safety/recovery item, jump starter  
Safety/recovery item, heavy duty jumper cables  
Safety/recovery item, set of flares & reflectors  
Safety/recovery item, tire repair kit w/inflator

Safety/recovery item, tow rope  
Safety/recovery item, traction aid (bag of sand or cinders, kitty litter, or a set of traction pads)  
Spare parts, battery  
Spare parts, cap, fuel tank(s)  
Spare parts, cap, radiator  
Spare parts, engine belts  
Spare parts, engine gaskets  
Spare parts, fuses, all types  
Spare parts, if space allows or hard to find (starter, alternator, steering & power brake pumps, etc.)  
Spare parts, ignition parts (conventional/electronic/digital)  
Spare parts, points/plugs/condenser/plug wires/replacement electronic ignition/computer  
Spare parts, radiator hoses  
Spare parts, wiper blades  
Spare tires, mounted  
Spare tires, un-mounted

Pair of coveralls, gloves & cap  
Tarp (to lay on when under car)  
Heavy duty flashlight with hanging loop and magnet  
Headlamp  
Extra batteries & bulbs for flashlight and headlamp  
Funnel (with adapters to fit all fluid filling points)  
Battery charger & long power cord
